PREMISE

When Metin (25) loses his secret diary he quickly realizes that nothing will be the same again, and that he must leave the suburb. Swedish slang MÅSTE GITT = MUST LEAVE.

SYNOPSIS

"An extraordinary Cut" is about METIN (25). He lives in Jordbro, a Swedish suburb. A place where the unwritten laws applies, their own courts have the last word. Where the youth are restless and forgotten.

Metins biggest flaw is that he can write, so he writes a diary, but he doesn't know that he writes fine literature. He writes about things he sees, hears and does. Everyone's names and places are documented in the book, even such details as time of action and color of clothing are written down. If the diary ends up in the hands of the police, it is an open testimony report where half of Jordbros population will end up in prison. If the diary ends up in the mobs hands Metin will get cut, killed.One day Metin loses his book and he know whats waiting for him. Nothing will be the same any more. A true movie inspired by personal experiences from Stockholm's suburbs.

DIRECTOR'S VISION

There is so much talent in this world who never get the guidance needed to find an outlet for their creativity. We wanted to make a film about the forgotten youth. We want to portray and highlight the basics of why some people get SO wrong, so they spend their best years inside the jail or even worst – down in the dark earth.

I was 13 years old when the war broke out in former Yugoslavia. My friends over the age of 18 participated at the front unless their fathers had already bought them a free pass and sent them abroad. Many of my neighbors and cousins who had just turned 18 that had just kissed their first girlfriend or had just got their driving license never came back. Sadly they remained in love and confused in the mud at the front between the trenches. Imagine what a waste of life and energy, a waste of talent and youth. The waste of youth and talent has always fascinated me. My previous films explores the same theme with similar characters, Knäcka, (Dreams) from 2009, and 10 Guds Siffror, (Remnants of a life) from 2013.And I see the same patterns were ever I look. No matter of social class and nationality. In Måste Gitt – 2017, (An Extraordinary Cut) you can see the Swedish suburbs from the inside. Waste of youth, so close...
